

1. Blanc de Mer, Bouchard Finlayson 2014 Walker Bay This blend is both bold in colour and structure. The composition enjoys Riesling as the primary player, with Viognier secondary followed by Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin Blanc and Chardonnay. It has a deep colour with a very full palate feel. Sauvignon Blanc, Bouchard Finlayson 2015 Walker Bay The geographic location of the winery, lying within five kilometres of the cool Atlantic Ocean offers the best temperature zone that the Cape can contribute to a strong vibrant aroma, tropical fruits of pineapple, lychee and passion fruit.
