THE BELGRAVIA



The largest venue within The Lanesborough and immediately accessible from the front hall, The Belgravia is a palatial setting for board meetings, wedding dinners and the most sophisticated of social occasions. Soaring ceilings and towering windows with commanding views across Hyde Park lend The Belgravia a stately, imperious air. Its recent refurbishment has re-illuminated the room's Regency splendour. Mirrors of blue Murano glass line the walls, amplifying the sense of grandeur and space, and extraordinary hand-painted panels adorn the ceiling.

THE ST. GEORGE'S


A warm, inviting and charismatic private dining room, St George's mixes Regency opulence with a hint of glamour. Three original Georgian windows frame views of a much-loved London landmark, Wellington Arch, erected at the same time as the hotel building, in celebration of Britain's victory in the Napoleonic Wars. High ceilings, chandeliers, period artworks, an original Regency fireplace and a dado featuring beautiful wood marquetry make for majestic surroundings; the carpet finishes the room with a dash of modern panache.

THE WELLINGTON


As befits a room so named, The Wellington evokes the grandeur and distinction of the great homes of the Regency period. Tall double pilasters around the walls and the room's ornate ceiling create an imposing setting, flanked at either end by 19th century fireplaces and majestic gilt mirrors. The Wellington Room adjoins The Westminster and Wilkins Rooms and can be used in conjunction with either, as a private dining or reception room, or as a breakout area for meetings.

THE WESTMINSTER



THE WILKINS




THE WINE CELLAR



THE WINDSOR



THE GREAT HALL






